ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED SO PLEASE ENTER EARLY

Throughout the day a points system will operate, and teams will be awarded points relevant to their placing in each class. i.e. 6 points for 1st, 5 for 2nd etc. The Pony Club who accumulates most points throughout the day, will win a £500 prize for training or equipment purchase.

CLASS 1

70cm – One round (see details below)

CLASS 2

70cm – Team Relay – (see details below)

**Classes 1 & 2 are only open to Juniors (14 yrs and under as of 1st Jan 2017).
Competitors in Classes 1 & 2 may not enter any other class.**

CLASS 3

80cm – One Round (See details below)

CLASS 4

80cm - Team Relay – (see details below)

CLASS 5

90cm - One Round (See details below)

CLASS 6

90cm – Team Relay – (see details below)

CLASS 7

1 metre - One Round (See details below)

CLASS 8

1 metre – Team Relay (see details below)

One Round Classes – single phase

Each team member to jump first part of course untimed (but with a time limit), then continue second part against the clock (the jump-off). Teams to consist of 4 members, the best 3 scores to count. If a team has 3, all scores will be counted.

Team Relay Classes

Teams must consist of 4 members, with all times to count. The team of 4 with the quickest aggregate time will be the winners. Any jumping faults will incur a 4 second penalty to be added to your time. Team to assemble in changeover area; when one rider returns, the next one sets off. No baton will be passed.

RESTRICTIONS:

Teams to consist of 4 riders.

Ponies/horses/riders may only jump one round per class.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. **Legal Liability** - Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible neither the Organisers of this event nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
2. **Health and Safety** – the Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.
3. **Safety Rules** - Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
4. **Photography**- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer.
5. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
6. The Judges' decisions are final.
7. All classes will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping rules 2017, except where specifically varied below.
8. **Hats of all competitors whether Pony Club members or not, must be tagged with a white Pony Club tag or red British Evening tag to confirm that it complies with the following standard.** It must bear the CE Mark AND a quality symbol: PAS 015:1998 or 2011; Snell E2001 with the official Snell label and number; ASTM F1163 2004a with the SEI kitemark; AS/NZS 3838 1998, 2003 or 2006. They must be worn with chin strap fastened at all times when mounted, with plain black, dark blue or brown covers only. A competitor whose hat comes off his/her head whilst riding in a competition must, on penalty of elimination, replace it before continuing.
9. Objections may only be made by team managers and must be submitted to the Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £10.
10. Rosettes to fourth place.
11. Each Team will be responsible for the Arena Party whilst Jumping.
12. Each Pony Club will receive one free ticket for entry to the event for their DC or team trainer.
